



Technical Bulletin: Cleaning your painted Vinyl Windows

Uncle Omer's paint is a quality blend of Polyurethane and Acrylic polymers. As such it will require very little cleaning after the paint has cured. In the event that cleaning is necessary, we recommend using warm water mixed with a mild household detergent such as Dawn dish washing detergent. Windex will also work.

When washing use a scrub brush purchased from your household cleaning section of your grocery store. Use of wire brushes should be avoided. Products such as Scotchbrite should also be avoided. Wash down the windows with a garden hose to remove dirt and debris.

During the construction phase of normal home building, drywall dust is normal to be deposited on windows. Use a garden hose and a scrub brush previously described to remove the drywall dust.

Warning:

During the bricklaying stage or stuccoing stage of construction, precautions should be taken to insure that brick mortar or stucco not be allowed to dry on painted surfaces of our vinyl windows. Wet brick mortar or stucco will not be problem for our paint integrity as long as it is wiped clean from the window, before it dries.
